

## Place Value: Easy Practice Paper 1 Answers

| Q# | Answer | Explanation                                                                                                       |
|----|--------|-------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| 1  | D      | The 5 is in the ten-thousands place, so its value is 50,000.                                                      |
| 2  | C      | In 1.24, the 4 is the second digit to the right of the decimal point, which is the hundredths place.              |
| 3  | C      | Three hundred thousand is 300,000. Adding twenty gives 300,020.                                                   |
| 4  | C      | The tenths place is the first digit to the right of the decimal point.                                            |
| 5  | D      | There are 100 pence in £1, so £4.50 is $4.50 \times 100 = 450\text{p}$ .                                          |
| 6  | C      | To round to the nearest thousand, we look at the hundreds digit (7). Since it is 5 or more, we round up to 9,000. |
| 7  | B      | Comparing them by adding placeholder zeros: 0.610 is larger than 0.601, 0.061, 0.600, and 0.160.                  |
| 8  | B      | 1,000 divided by 10 is 100, so 100 tens make 1,000.                                                               |
| 9  | B      | Dividing by 10 moves the digits one place to the right, so 0.9 becomes 0.09.                                      |
| 10 | B      | A 4-digit number cannot start with 0. The next smallest digit is 2, followed by the 0, then 5 and 8.              |
| 11 | B      | $19,450 + 1,000 = 20,450$ .                                                                                       |
| 12 | B      | The 3 is in the tenths place of the pounds, which represents 30 pence.                                            |
| 13 | D      | The units place is the digit immediately to the left of the decimal point.                                        |
| 14 | A      | 0.4 is the same as 0.400. Since 400 thousandths is more than 399 thousandths, 0.4 is greater.                     |
| 15 | C      | $500 + 20 + 14 = 534$ .                                                                                           |
