

English Spelling: Easy Practice Paper 2 Answers

Q#	Answer	Explanation
1	B	'becuase' should be spelled 'because'. The word is be plus cause, so the a comes before the u: be-cause. The mistake is in group B.
2	A	'Runing' should be spelled 'Running'. Run ends in a short vowel and a single consonant, so the n is doubled before -ing: run + n + ing. The mistake is in group A.
3	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Finally is final plus -ly, which gives it two l letters, and Friday keeps the i of Fri-. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
4	C	'tryed' should be spelled 'tried'. When -ed is added to a word ending in a consonant and y, the y changes to i: try + ed gives tried. The mistake is in group C.
5	D	'carful' should be spelled 'careful'. The e of care is kept when -ful is added, and -ful has only one l: care + ful. The mistake is in group D.
6	A	'Wich' should be spelled 'Which'. Like when, where and why, the question word begins with wh. The mistake is in group A.
7	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Carefully is careful plus -ly, so it has two l letters, and listened keeps its silent t. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
8	B	'tomorow' should be spelled 'tomorrow'. It has one m and then a double r: to-morrow. The mistake is in group B.
9	D	'babys' should be spelled 'babies'. A noun ending in a consonant and y changes the y to i and adds -es: baby becomes babies. The mistake is in group D.
10	C	'makeing' should be spelled 'making'. Make ends in a silent e, and that e is dropped before -ing: mak(e) + ing gives making. The mistake is in group C.
