

Place Value: Hard Practice Paper 4 Answers

Q#	Answer	Explanation
1	E	The digit 8 is in the ten-thousands place.
2	A	Multiplying by 1,000 moves the decimal three places to the right.
3	A	49,995 is only 5 away from 50,000.
4	A	Add place values: $600,000 + 30,000 + 8,000 + 400 + 20 + 7$.
5	C	0.860 has the greatest hundredths value compared with the others.
6	A	71,652 rounds up because the hundreds are more than 500.
7	A	Dividing by 100 moves the decimal two places to the left.
8	A	$0.7 + 0.06 + 0.003 = 0.763$.
9	B	0.980 has the largest tenths and hundredths combination.
10	A	$400,000 + 80,000 + 3,000 + 60 + 1 = 483,061$.
11	A	62 thousandths means 62 in the thousandths place.
12	A	Multiplying by 100 shifts digits two places left.
13	A	The hundredths place is the second digit after the decimal.
14	A	Adding 10,000 increases the ten-thousands digit by one.
15	A	0.206 is smallest, then 0.26, and 0.602 is the largest.
