

English Spelling: Hard Practice Paper 6 Answers

Q#	Answer	Explanation
1	B	'rythm' should be spelled 'rhythm'. It keeps an h after the r, as rhyme does: r-h-ythm. The mistake is in group B.
2	D	'exilarating' should be spelled 'exhilarating'. There is a silent h after the ex: ex-h-ilarating. The mistake is in group D.
3	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Committee has a double m, a double t and a double e, and annual has two n letters. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
4	A	'minature' should be spelled 'miniature'. It is built on mini, so an i follows the min: min-i-ature. The mistake is in group A.
5	C	'garantee' should be spelled 'guarantee'. It begins with the gua of guard: g-u-arantee. The mistake is in group C.
6	D	'disasterous' should be spelled 'disastrous'. The e of disaster is dropped when -ous is added: disast(e)r + ous. The mistake is in group D.
7	B	'nuisence' should be spelled 'nuisance'. The ending is -ance and not -ence: nuis-a-nce. The mistake is in group B.
8	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Pharmacist begins with the ph that sounds like f, and dosage drops the silent e of dose before the -age. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
9	C	'extrordinary' should be spelled 'extraordinary'. It joins extra to ordinary and keeps every letter of both: extra + ordinary. The mistake is in group C.
10	A	'silouette' should be spelled 'silhouette'. There is a silent h after the sil: sil-h-ouette. The mistake is in group A.
