Q#	Answer	Explanation
1	B	'exited' should be spelled 'excited'. There is a c after the ex: ex-c-ited. Exited without the c means went out of a room. The mistake is in group B.
2	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Building keeps its silent u after the b, and their is the spelling that shows who the nests belong to. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
3	C	'siting' should be spelled 'sitting'. Sit ends in a short vowel and a single consonant, so the t is doubled before -ing: sit + t + ing. The mistake is in group C.
4	D	'rideing' should be spelled 'riding'. Ride ends in a silent e, and that e is dropped before -ing: rid(e) + ing gives riding. The mistake is in group D.
5	A	'carryed' should be spelled 'carried'. A verb ending in a consonant and y changes the y to i before -ed: carry becomes carried. The mistake is in group A.
6	C	'helpfull' should be spelled 'helpful'. The ending -ful is spelled with one l when it is added to a word: help + ful. The mistake is in group C.
7	B	'theif' should be spelled 'thief'. There is no c in front of it, so it is i before e: th-ie-f. The mistake is in group B.
8	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Queued keeps the ue of queue before the -ed, and patiently is patient with -ly added. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
9	D	'shelfs' should be spelled 'shelves'. A noun ending in f changes the f to v and adds -es: shelf becomes shelves. The mistake is in group D.
10	A	'atention' should be spelled 'attention'. There are two t letters in the middle: at-t-ention. The mistake is in group A.
