

English Spelling: Medium Practice Paper 6 Answers

Q#	Answer	Explanation
1	A	'necessary' should be spelled 'necessary'. It has one c and then two s letters: ne-c-e-ss-ary. The mistake is in group A.
2	C	'disapointed' should be spelled 'disappointed'. It is the prefix dis- put in front of appoint, so the two p letters of appoint are kept: dis + appoint + ed. The mistake is in group C.
3	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Rehearsal is rehearse with the silent e dropped before -al, and Thursday begins with a capital letter as the days of the week do. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
4	B	'imediately' should be spelled 'immediately'. There are two m letters after the opening i: i-mm-ediately. The mistake is in group B.
5	D	'neice' should be spelled 'niece'. There is no c in front of it, so it is i before e: n-ie-ce. The mistake is in group D.
6	C	'strenght' should be spelled 'strength'. It ends with the same -gth as length: stren-g-th. The mistake is in group C.
7	E	Every word here is spelled correctly. Neighbour keeps its silent gh, and length keeps the g before the th. So there is no mistake in this sentence.
8	D	'furnature' should be spelled 'furniture'. The ending is spelled -iture, with an i and not an a: furn-i-ature. The mistake is in group D.
9	A	'oposite' should be spelled 'opposite'. There are two p letters in the middle: op-p-osite. The mistake is in group A.
10	B	'sincerly' should be spelled 'sincerely'. The e at the end of sincere is kept when -ly is added: sincere + ly. The mistake is in group B.
